Written Statement of Behaviour Principles

- Everyone in the school shares the vision of Loving All Our Neighbours
- Every pupil understands they have the right to feel safe, valued and respected, and learn free from anxiety and the disruption of others
- All pupils, staff, volunteers and visitors are free from any form of discrimination
- Staff and volunteers set an excellent example to pupils at all times
- Rewards, sanctions and reasonable force are used consistently by staff, in line with the behaviour policy
- The behaviour policy is understood by pupils, staff and volunteers
- The exclusions policy explains that exclusions will only be used as a last resort, and outlines the processes involved in permanent and fixed-term exclusions
- Pupils are helped to take responsibility for their actions
- Families are involved in behaviour incidents to foster good relationships between the school and pupils' home life
- The school will give support to both the victims and perpetrators of inappropriate behaviour

The Governing Body also emphasises that violence or threatening behaviour will not be tolerated in any circumstances.

This written statement of behaviour principles will be reviewed and approved by Curriculum Committee of the Governing Body annually.
