Dear Parents & Carers

Last week our year 5's went on their school trip to Kew Gardens which links with their geography topic looking at different landscapes around the world. It was glorious weather and I know the children had a brilliant time. Look out for more details in the year 5 class spotlight in two weeks' time.

Eco Club News:

Things have been growing fast around school, and not just the plants. Our Growing Club has been busy getting their hands properly dirty, sowing seeds for flowers and vegetables, propagating new plants and taking real responsibility for looking after them. The raised beds are being watered, weeded and cared for with real attention, and it shows.

We are also excited to launch our **Spring Plant Swap**, which will run until May half-term. Children and families are invited to take part by bringing in a plant, seedling or cutting to swap. We also welcome donations of gardening tools or decorative plant pot covers to support our outdoor areas. This is a great opportunity to encourage sharing, growing, and a love of nature within our community.





In May, we will be running **Shoesday Tuesday**. Every Tuesday in May, children can wear colourful or creatively decorated shoes or trainers. This could be as simple as bright shoelaces or small decorations. The idea behind this is to encourage conversations about walking, cycling, and choosing more eco-friendly ways to travel, helping to raise awareness about climate change in a simple, visible way. Safety comes first, so all footwear must be suitable for school, and on PE days children should wear trainers that are appropriate for physical activity.



To support this, on Tuesdays in May, parents can drop children off at All Saints Church between 8:20 and 8:25, where a member of school staff will meet them and walk them safely to school. We hope this will help families who live a little further away and need to use the car to drop the children off at school!
