## **MyChildAtSchool (MCAS)**

Dear Parents/Carers

We are pleased to inform you that our school is launching MyChildAtSchool (MCAS), an online portal designed to give you secure, real-time access to important information about your child's school life.

Through *MCAS*, you will be able to view:

- Attendance and punctuality
- School announcements and messages
- School dinner preorder, balances and payments
- Other online payments
- Bookings for clubs and wraparound care
- Parental consent · Parents Evening

Over the next few weeks, you will receive an email from *MCAS* asking you to reset your password. Please follow the link in that email to set up your account. **Do not attempt to self-register or log in before receiving this email**, as your account will not be active until the password reset process is completed. Once your password has been set, you will be able to access *MCAS* through the website or by downloading the MyChildAtSchool app, available free on both Apple and Android devices.

We believe *MCAS* will strengthen communication between home and school by making key information easier to access and helping you stay connected with your child's progress.

### Expansion of Free School Meals



The Government has confirmed that from September 2026, all children in households receiving Universal Credit will be entitled to Free School Meals, regardless of household income.

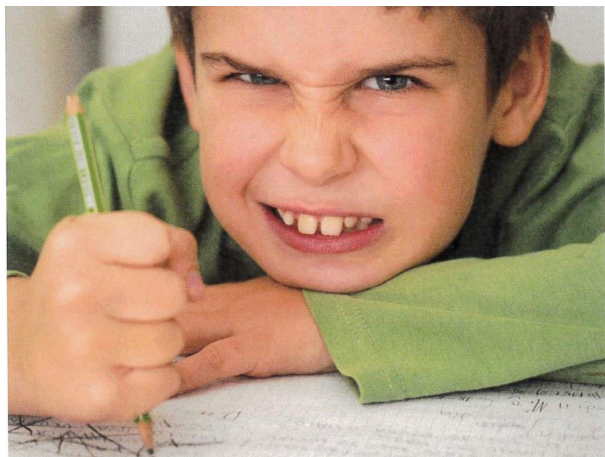
