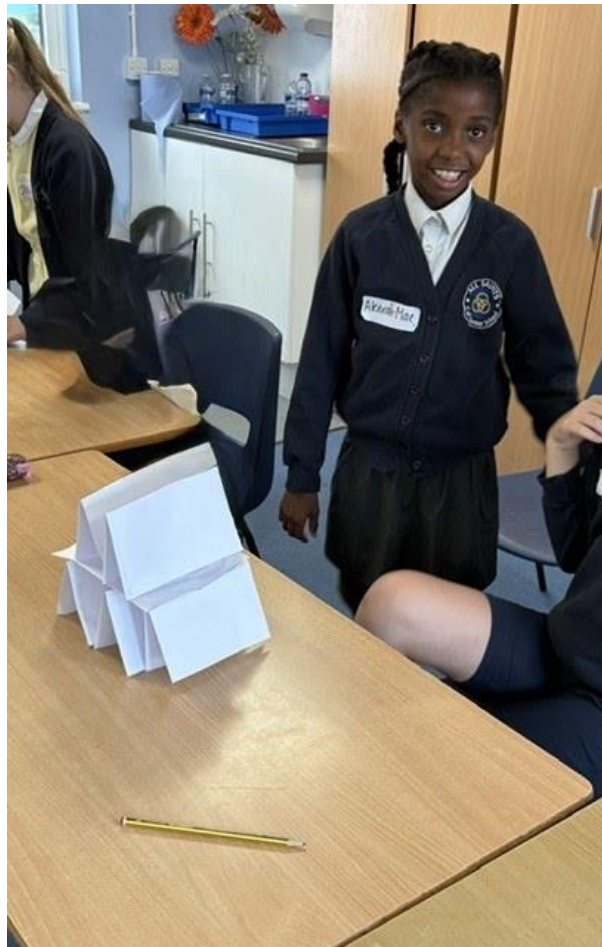

You will have received an email from *MCAS* last week asking you to reset your password.

Please follow the link in that email to set up your account.

Once your password has been set, you will be able to access *MCAS* through the website www.mychildatschool.com or by downloading the MyChildAtSchool app, available free on both Apple and Android devices.

Initially, you will be able to access and view the following:

- **Attendance and punctuality** – check your child's attendance and report absences directly to the school through MCAS
- **School announcements and messages** – communications will be sent to you through MCAS
- **Student and Contact Details** – Check your child's details and make changes to address/telephone numbers etc.
- **Parental consent** – View and amend your parental consent options
- **School dinner preorder, balances and payments**- new for September 2026! School lunches can now be pre-ordered and paid for through MCAS, *not Tucasi*. Further details to follow.

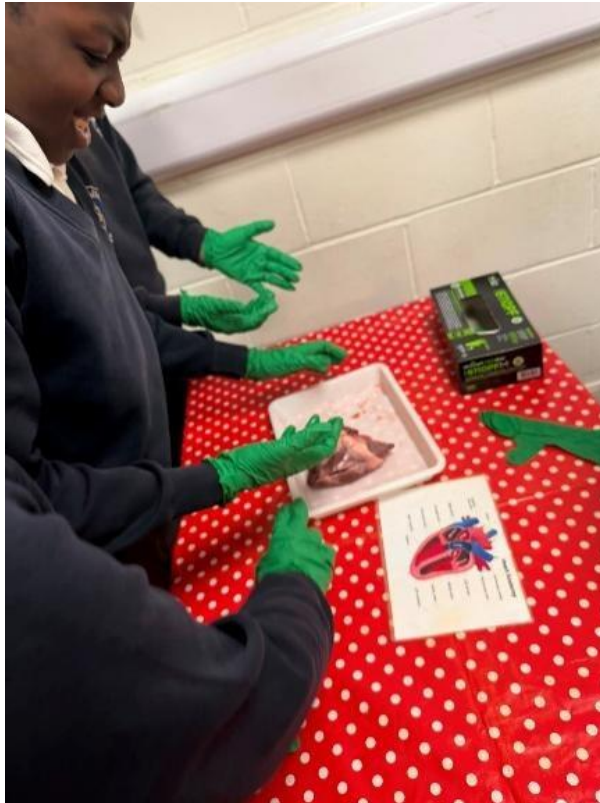
