Dear Parents & Carers

Firstly, a warm welcome back to a new academic year at All Saints and a warm welcome to all of our new parents and carers who have children starting their time at All Saints. We hope you all had a wonderful summer break and enjoyed the glorious weather! The first week back has been fantastic with each class settling into the school routines very quickly and we've seen lots of happy, smiling faces throughout the school which is a great sign!

For those not familiar, our newsletter will be sent out each week on Wednesdays and will include updated key dates/events coming up, any key messages or reflections on the school week from myself, a different class update, any key SEND information, sports updates and pupil awards given out for the week. We hope you can find this useful for any forward planning or to see some of the brilliant things our pupils get up to through the year!

This week I would like to point you to the **key dates** section for this Autumn Term, we have included everything that is in our calendar at the moment up until Christmas! As the weeks go by I am sure other events will be added as they are confirmed but again, I hope this can be helpful to plan ahead or keep certain dates in mind!

As you can see, the first key date is next **Wednesday 16th September** where we will run our **'Meet the Teacher'** sessions. Uniform and PE KIT Reminders

Since returning the children have looked very smart and we want to keep it that way through the year! So just a few reminders regarding uniform.

If your child likes to wear one of our fleeces, these are for outside use only. In class the children should wear a school jumper as an extra layer.

If your child has PE or a lunchtime sports club, they can wear their PE kit to school.

If your child has a lunchtime sports club, they are expected to change afterwards as they may get wet or muddy. If they have PE in the afternoon extra PE clothing is required. If they don't have PE on that day, school uniform appropriate to the season should be changed into.

If your child has an after-school sports club, they **MUST** wear school uniform to school and will be given 5 minutes at the end of the day by their teacher to change into sport clothing ready for their after-school club.

CYCLING SHORTS and LEGGINGS ARE NOT PE KIT – Please make sure your child has the appropriate navy shorts or navy skort and navy track suit bottoms for use during the school day. Other sport clothing can be worn to after-school clubs.

Medication

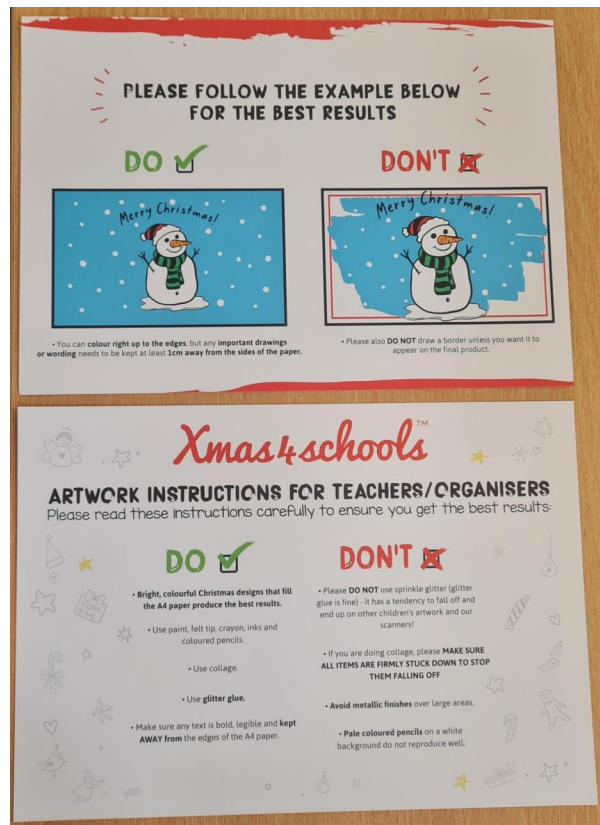
Dear Parents,
