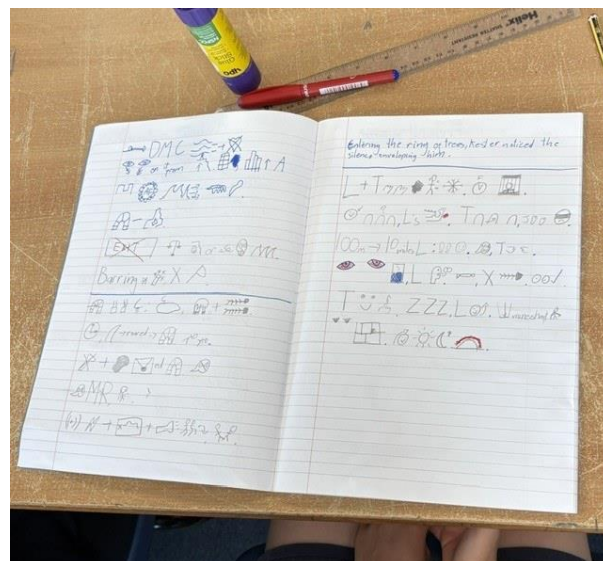
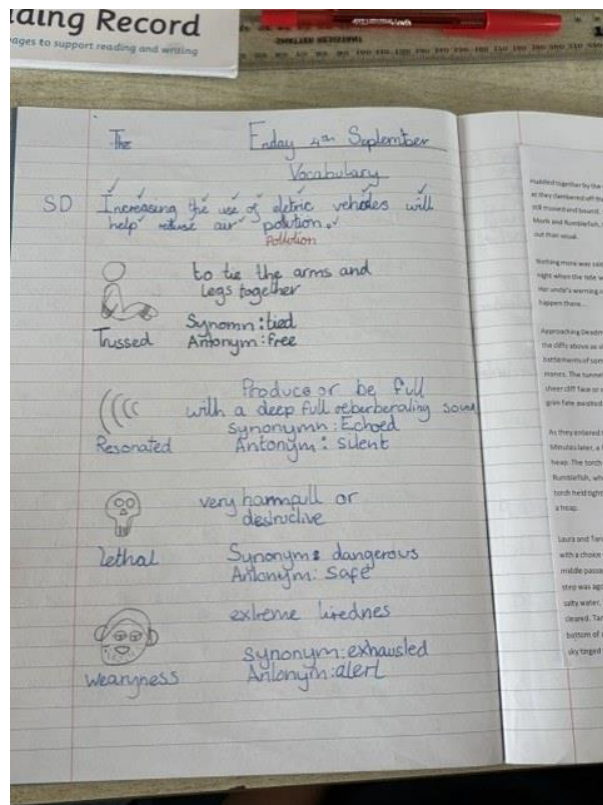
Class Spotlight - Hadid

In class Hadid we have started the new term brilliantly with all pupils settling into the routines of our class and diving into the curriculum! Our pupils have all applied for various leadership roles with our head pupils already allocated, we now need to decide who will become sports leaders, digital leaders and school councillors.

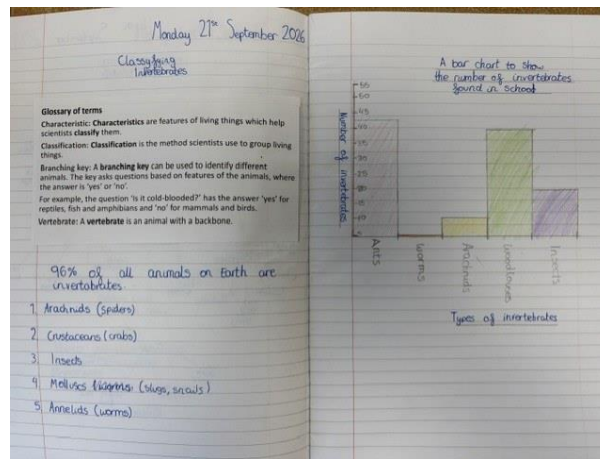
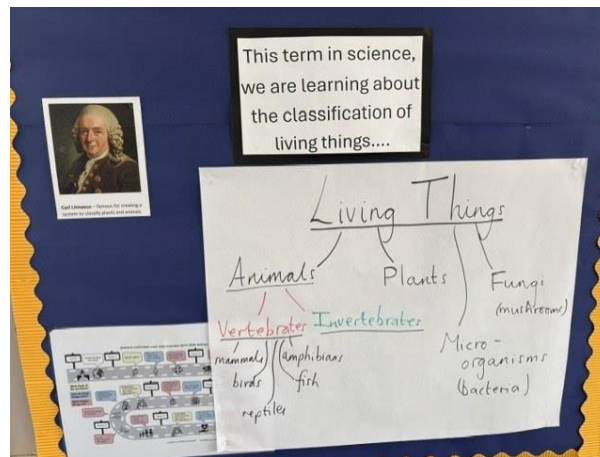




In Writing we have begun our 'adventure suspense' unit where our children have studied and learnt the text 'Deadman's Cove'. Which follows the tense journey of two hostages through the dangerous environment of the cove set in Cornwall. Currently the children are using the techniques used by the writer to plan their own story and will eventually produce their own adventure suspense tale -we look forward to reading them!



In reading, we begin our first text of the year called 'The Last Wild' by Piers Torday. It is set in a dystopian future where a deadly plague called the "red-eye virus" has wiped out almost all animals. Our main hero, a mute 12-year-old boy named Kester Jaynes discovers he can talk to the last surviving animals on Earth. The children have loved reading this so far as we continue with this incredible children's adventure.



In computing we began with a focus on online safety and we are now moving into coding inscratch and eventually Python which is more complex and advanced coding - a challenge for both pupils and teachers!!

In history, the children are studying crime and punishment as a topic over the last 1000 years. Part of the history curriculum requires the children to learn about the history of a concept over a period of 1000 years and this is proving to be very popular with the children.

Finally, those children that are attending the Rhos-Y-Gwaliau residential trip in November, there will be a final meeting on Thursday in Class Hawking with Mr Parkin to confirm those final details and logistics for the trip on Sunday 8th November.
